



In FY 2020, the Health Resources and Services Administration (HRSA), through the Federal Office of Rural Health Policy (FORHP) provided \$3.9 million to Wyoming to support to increase health care access, strengthen health networks, focus on quality improvement and encourage collaboration among rural communities. FORHP funding also supports the State Offices of Rural Health (SORH) to strengthen rural health care delivery systems and supporting quality improvement activities for small rural and Critical Access hospitals. FORHP also supports the advancement of telehealth and provides funding for telehealth grants and resource centers. FORHP supports programs charged with reducing the morbidity and mortality associated with substance use disorder, including opioid use disorder, in high risk rural communities as well as addressing the COVID-19 pandemic.
